### Youth Work Day & the Good Citizenship Award The Union League of Philadelphia October 3, 2013

#### How It Started:

The Youth Work program began in 1946 as a way to recognize and reward good citizenship and encourage young people to become active and informed citizen leaders. Community youth organizations and clubs nominate students for the Good Citizenship Award. Every year since 1946 close to 300 students gather for the day to meet each other, listen to interesting speakers, and debate important issues about the rights and responsibilities of being a good citizen of the United States.

#### What the Day Holds for You:

Youth Work Day starts at 8a.m. at The Union League of Philadelphia. In the morning session you will sit in small groups for fun "ice-breakers," role playing, and discussion about the rights and responsibilities of U.S. citizenship. After lunch, the whole group will travel to the Federal Court House at 6th & Market Street. Judges and lawyers will then lead you through debate on legal cases, leaving you to decide the verdict. A team of adults will accompany you throughout the day, participating in the activities with you. After court, everyone returns to the Union League for a reception, followed by the evening banquet. All participants are required to take part in all aspects of the day including small and large group discussions, legal deliberations and patriotic symbols and traditions. There will be good food, good conversation with old and new friends, and door prize drawings. The highlight of the evening is the presentation of the Good Citizenship Award medals and certificates to you and the other nominees.

#### Transportation:

You are responsible for your own transportation to the Union League in the morning and for your return trip home in the evening. Please arrive in the morning at 8:00a.m. The program will conclude between 8:00 and 8:30 p.m. Transportation between the Union League and the Federal Court House will be provided.

#### School:

Most schools will count this day as an excused absence. You will be provided a letter for you to supply to your principal as proof of an excused absence.

#### Parents:

We regret that we cannot accommodate parents during the day program or at the evening banquet. We will be streaming the banquet portion of Youth Work Day, via our website, <a href="https://www.ulheritagecenter.org">www.ulheritagecenter.org</a>. Please visit the website on October 3. Following Youth Work Day, you and your family will be invited to come back to the Union League for a special program for Good Citizenship



Security:

At the Federal Court House everyone will go through metal detectors. To make this process as fast and smooth as possible, plan to take nothing with you except a **photo ID which is required for entrance**. Anything you bring with you for the day will be stored in a secure, locked area at The Union League when we leave for the Court House. We will retrieve those items from the locked area once everyone return to the League for the reception and evening festivities. Leave your heavy backpacks at home, and bring only what you absolutely need for the day!

Dear Parents/Guardians of Good Citizenship Awardees,


